I. PEOPLE

A. Physical Distancing. To ensure employees comply with physical distancing requirements, you agree that you will do the following:

- Ensure 6 ft. distance between personnel, unless safety or core function of the work activity requires a shorter distance. Any time personnel are less than 6 ft. apart from one another, personnel must wear acceptable face coverings.
- Tightly confined spaces will be occupied by only one individual at a time, unless all occupants are wearing face coverings. If occupied by more than one person, will keep occupancy under 50% of maximum capacity.

- Post social distancing markers using tape or signs that denote 6 ft. of spacing in commonly used and other applicable areas on the site (e.g. clock in/out stations, health screening stations)
- Limit in-person gatherings as much as possible and use tele- or video-conferencing whenever possible. Essential in-person gatherings (e.g. meetings) should be held in open, well-ventilated spaces with appropriate social distancing among participants.
- Establish designated areas for pick-ups and deliveries, limiting contact to the extent possible.

PASSENGERS IN THE TRUCK WILL WEAR MASKS AND LEAVE WINDOWS OPEN. WHEN POSSIBLE TEAM MEMBERS WILL MEET AT THE JOBSITE AND NOT TRAVEL IN THE TRUCK. 2 PERSON MAXIMUM IN AN ELEVATOR. MINIMAL NUMBER OF MOVERS WILL BE ASSIGNED TO JOBS.

EMPLOYEES WILL MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING DURING THEIR BREAKS AND STAGGER BREAKS.

II. PLACES

A. Protective Equipment. To ensure employees comply with protective equipment requirements, you agree that you will do the following:

- Employers must provide employees with an acceptable face covering at no-cost to the employee and have an adequate supply of coverings in case of replacement.

What quantity of face coverings – and any other PPE – will you need to procure to ensure that you always have a sufficient supply on hand for employees and visitors? How will you procure these supplies?

WE HAVE PURCHASED IN BULK 10,000 DISPOSABLE MASKS AND GLOVES. WE WILL REPLENISH WHEN NECESSARY. WE ALSO HAVE AVAILABLE DISPOSABLE OVERALLS AND BOOTIES. WE ANTICIPATE CONTINUED USE OF MASKS AND GLOVES FOR THE FORESEEABLE FUTURE.

- Face coverings must be cleaned or replaced after use or when damaged or soiled, may not be shared, and should be properly stored or discarded.

What policy will you implement to ensure that PPE is appropriately cleaned, stored, and/or discarded?
EMPLOYEES ARE REQUIRED TO KEEP EXTRA PPE AND HAND SANITIZER ON THE TRUCK AND A BAG TO DISPOSE OF USED PPE. THEY ARE INSTRUCTED TO NOT LEAVE USED PPE IN THE CLIENT OR BUILDING TRASH RECEPTICLE

- Limit the sharing of objects and discourage touching of shared surfaces; or, when in contact with shared objects or frequently touched areas, wear gloves (trade-appropriate or medical); or, sanitize or wash hands before and after contact.

List common objects that are likely to be shared between employees. What measures will you implement to ensure the safety of your employees when using these objects?
DOLLIES, MOVING BLANKETS, TOOLS, TRUCK DOOR HANDLES. EQUIPMENT AND TRUCKS ARE SANITIZED DAILY AND ALL EMPLOYEES HAVE ACCESS TO HAND SANITIZER AND WEAR DISPOSABLE GLOVES.

B. Hygiene and Cleaning. To ensure employees comply with hygiene and cleaning requirements, you agree that you will do the following:

- Adhere to hygiene and sanitation requirements from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Department of Health (DOH) and maintain cleaning logs on site that document date, time, and scope of cleaning.

- Provide and maintain hand hygiene stations for personnel, including handwashing with soap, water, and paper towels, or an alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing 60% or more alcohol for areas where handwashing is not feasible.

Where on the work location will you provide employees with access to the appropriate hand hygiene and/or sanitizing products and how will you promote good hand hygiene?
THE MOVERS ARE TO MAINTAIN EXTRA PPE AND HAND SANTIZER ON THE TRUCKS.

- Conduct regular cleaning and disinfection at least after every shift, daily, or more frequently as needed, and frequent cleaning and disinfection of shared objects (e.g. tools, machinery) and surfaces, as well as high transit areas, such as restrooms and common areas, must be completed.

What policies will you implement to ensure regular cleaning and disinfection of your worksite and any shared objects or materials, using products identified as effective against COVID-19?

THE TRUCKS ARE SANTIZED EVERY DAY WHEN THEY RETURN TO THE DISPATCH. THE MOVERS MAINTAIN WIPES ON THE TRUCK FOR INTERMITENT CLEANING.

C. Communication. To ensure the business and its employees comply with communication requirements, you agree that you will do the following:

- Post signage throughout the site to remind personnel to adhere to proper hygiene, social distancing rules, appropriate use of PPE, and cleaning and disinfecting protocols.
- Establish a communication plan for employees, visitors, and customers with a consistent means to provide updated information.
- Maintain a continuous log of every person, including workers and visitors, who may have close contact with other individuals at the work site or area; excluding deliveries that are performed with appropriate PPE or through contactless means; excluding customers, who may be encouraged to provide contact information to be logged but are not mandated to do so.
